Robot Making Competition

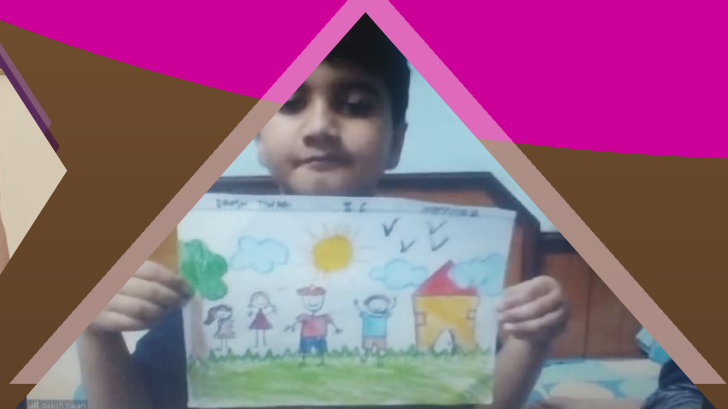

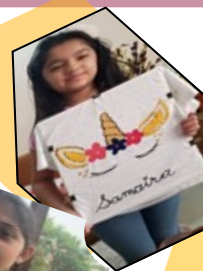


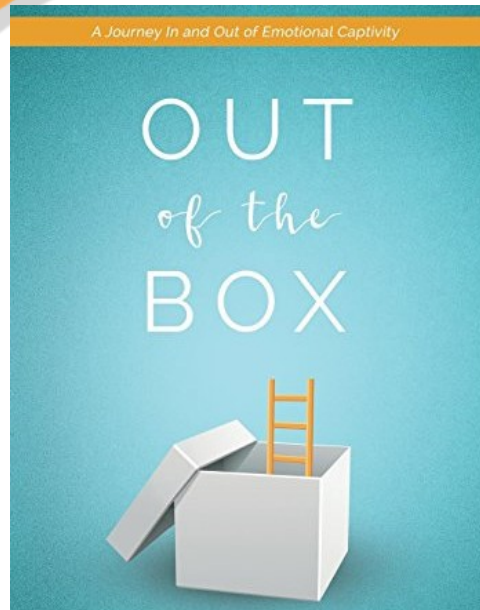


Paint My T-shirt

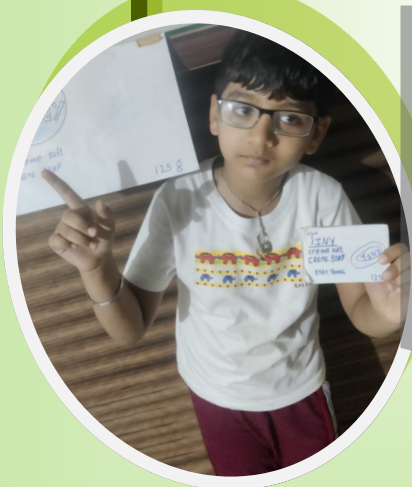
Declamation

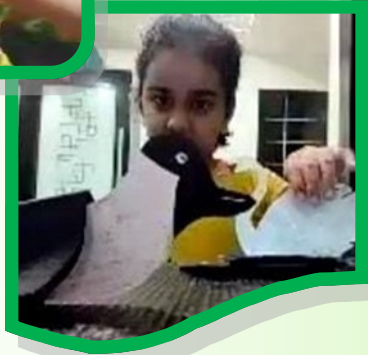
Crusaders of Earth

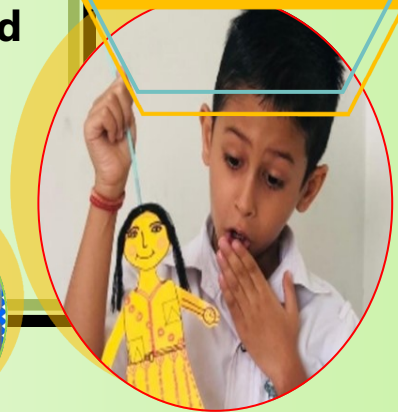

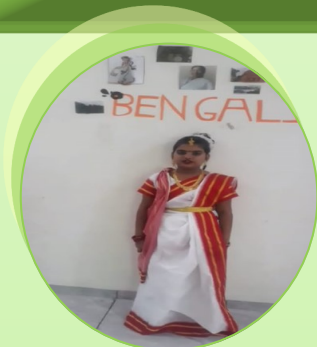

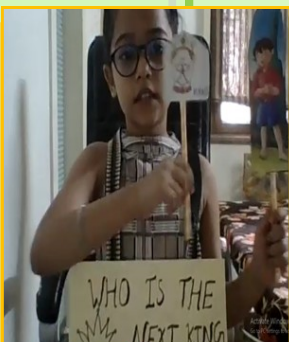

Show and tell: Community helpers

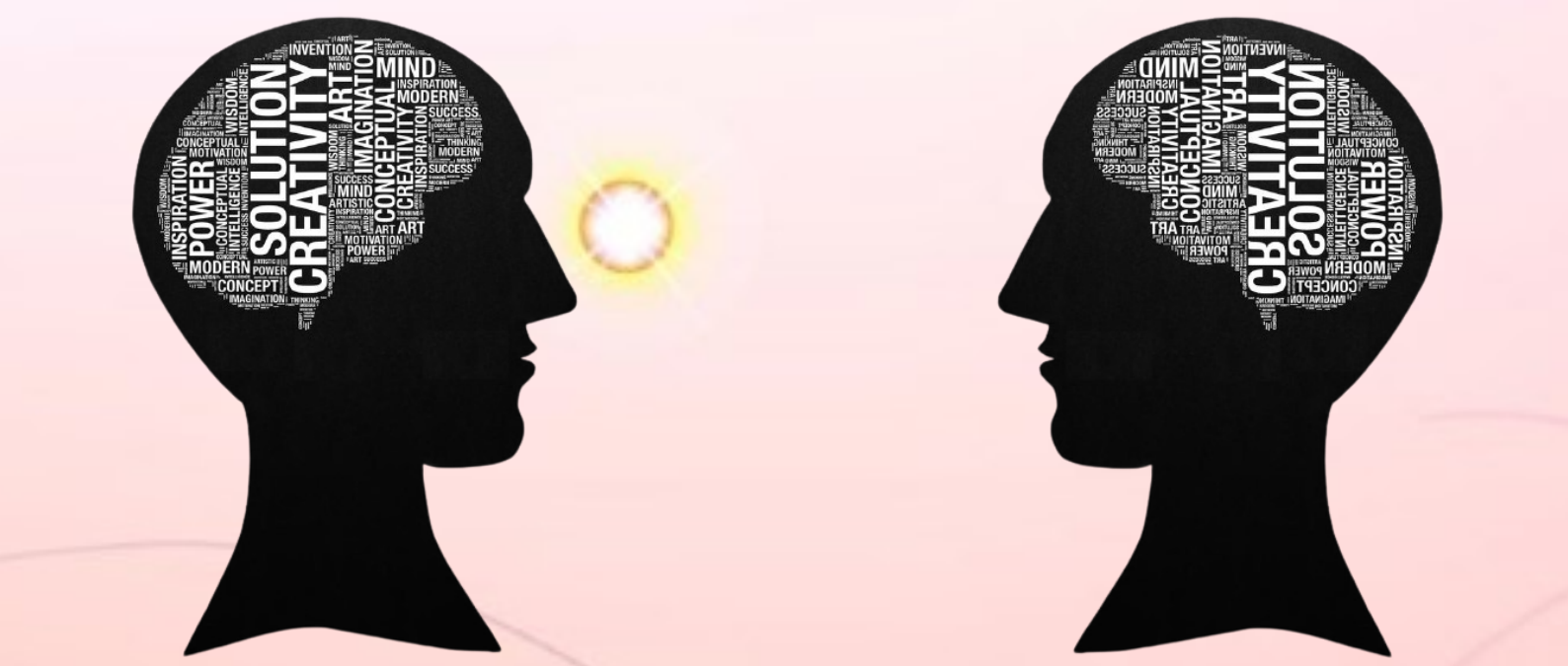

- *It is always good to have great expectation and ambition in life which in turn will encourage us to take positive step thus bringing excitement and happiness.*

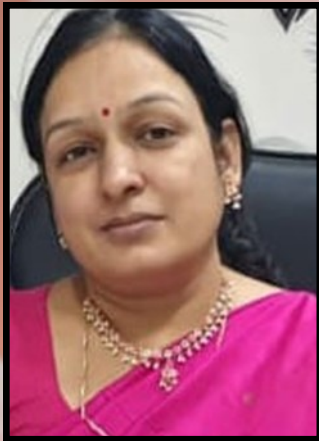

9 Planets You Could Live On Right Now

Trappist-1e: TRAPPIST-1e, also designated as 2MASS J23062928-0502285 e, is a solid, close-to-Earth-sized exoplanet orbiting within the habitable zone around the ultracool dwarf star TRAPPIST-1 approximately 40 light-years away from Earth in the constellation of Aquarius.

Proxima b: Proxima Centauri b is an exoplanet orbiting in the habitable zone of the red dwarf star Proxima Centauri, which is the closest star to the Sun and part of a triple star system

Ross 128 b: Ross 128 is a red dwarf in the equatorial zodiac constellation of Virgo, near β Virginias. The apparent magnitude of Ross 128 is 11.13, which is too faint to be seen with the unaided eye.

Gliese 581g: Gliese 581g is an extra-solar planet candidate within a planetary system that is only 20 light-years from Earth, but at this point it is highly doubted to exist. ... The original researchers that found Gliese 581g in 2010, however, defended their methods in 2012 and cast doubts on some of the other teams' work.

Kepler-22b: Kepler-22b is an exoplanet orbiting within the habitable zone of the Sun-like star Kepler-22. It is located about 600 light-years from Earth in the constellation of Cygnus.

KOI 7711.01: Lies in the planetary system of the star KOI, KOI 7711.01 is a planet about some few million light years away from the planet Earth. Not much is found about this planet, but space agencies such as NASA are still trying to find more about this mysterious planet.

Kepler-186f: Kepler-186f is an exoplanet orbiting the red dwarf Kepler-186, about 500 light-years from the Earth. It is the first planet with a radius similar to Earth's to be discovered in the habitable zone of another star.

Kepler-62f: Kepler-62f is a super-Earth exoplanet orbiting within the habitable zone of the star Kepler-62, the outermost of five such planets discovered around the star by NASA's Kepler spacecraft. It is located about 990 light-years from Earth in the constellation of Lyra.

Kepler-62e: Kepler-62e is a super-Earth exoplanet discovered orbiting within the habitable zone of Kepler-62, the second outermost of five such planets discovered by NASA's Kepler spacecraft. Kepler-62e is located about 990 light-years from Earth in the constellation of Lyra.

How does Rockets work.?

Newton's third law of motion for every action there is an equal and opposite reaction it is a suitable example to describe the fundamental working of a rocket which expects to launch the action is the gush of exhaust gases from the rear of the vehicle that is produced by the combustion of the weaker student's rocket engine the reaction is the pressure called thrust which is applied to the internal structure of the rocket that pushes it in the opposite direction of the exhaust flow rockets carry their own oxidising agent so that they can operate in the vacuum beyond the atmosphere. stages of launch - the basic way to launch a rocket into the space was first suggested by KONSTANTIN TSIOLKOVSKY. he suggested that it is the best to separate the vehicle into different stages First stage it consists of the largest rocket engines biggest fuels an oxidiser tanks and maximum thrust its primary function is to impact the initial thrust indeed it overcomes earth gravity and thrust to lift the entire weight of the weaker and its payload of the earth when the first stage of propellants are completely used it is detached from the other parts of the launch vehicle and falls back to the earth neither into the ocean or onto a scarcely populated area. Second stage at the second stage rocket engines and propellers continue to speed up the vehicle most expendable rocket launchers have only two or three stages earlier they had up to five stages in order to attain orbital velocity when the mission on the stage is completed it either falls back to earth enters the orbit itself all breaks apart and evaporates as it comes in contact with us most fierce heating while falling back towards earth Upper stages -all launch vehicles more than one stage to accelerate spacecraft to orbit velocity till the first orbital launch sputnik in 1957 there have been many different upper stages most are used as part for only one type of launch vehicles their valuation of this upper stage is did I buy desire to introduce more modern technology that will increase the overall lift capability of the launch vehicle lowers costs and increases reliability or a combination of these factors. The Chinese were the first to use the principle of a rocket propelled by gunpowder to launch.
