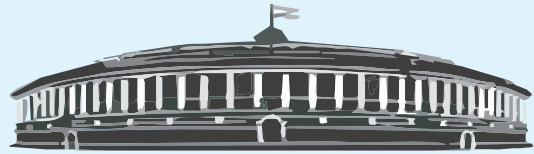

Money or Men?

"Was it an actual emergency?" surfaced the question, as an adrenaline rush accompanied the abrupt sirens that went off in the committee rooms, indicating the news of the Indian airplane, Boeing 123, being hijacked by the Eastern Front (EF), a terrorist organization known for its ruthless tactics. The delegations of various countries collectively came up with solutions to help tackle this grave threat to international peace and security.

In accordance with its non-negotiation policy, the USA offered three of its high-resolution surveillance satellites to locate the aircraft. Its alliance with Turkey was questioned by Germany since the former is suspected of aiding the EF. Spain

gave the utmost priority to civilians' lives, declaring a transfer of its direct funding of the governments of Turkey and Syria to their respective UNHRC bodies.

Pakistan contradicted their own statements by affirming that they are in communication with the alleged parties but have no ties with them. Members of the Lok Sabha graced the joint committee session with their presence, announcing the steps they were planning to take, including a donation of 10 billion dollars from the USA and constant contact between the aerospace authorities of Myanmar and

the Indian DGCA. Moreover, a team for negotiation purposes has been formed.

"Violence can be taught in its own language," claimed Israel, solidifying the need for a military invasion in Myanmar following the forced landing of the aircraft. "It's not that big of a deal," said the nation, implying the insignificance of the lives of Myanma as compared to those of the five vice chairs on board. France's and Italy's joint recommendation to the International Organisation of Countries to collaborate with the Indian government to try and identify the hijackers was objected to since they did not promote direct involvement.

"Okay, that might sound contradictory," admitted Thailand, when it suggested the presence of a 'monarchical democracy, but it assured that the elections conducted are free and fair. It advocated releasing a minimum amount of terrorists while also promoting the fulfilment of the EF's demands by contributing to the 30 million USD in cryptocurrency. Some countries have claimed to be the champions of democracy but what is a democracy that gives rise to terrorist organizations?
