

## CBSE WEST ZONE TENNIS (BOYS & GIRLS) 2025-26

(Date: 02 August to 05 August 2025)

- 1. CBSE Tennis Tournament will be played according to the rules and regulations of AITA unless otherwise modified in these Rules.
- 2. Each school can send one team, comprising a maximum of four players, in both the age groups, i.e., under 14, 17, and 19 Years, separately in the 'Boys & Girls' category.
- 3. The tournament at the Zone level shall be played on a **knockout basis**. In case the number of teams at Zone level is less, the tournament may be organized on league cum knock out basis.
- 4. All the matches shall be played as best of 13 (thirteen) games, with six all as a tie breaker. Semi-final will be played on a "short set" basis and finals will be played on the best of three sets with a tie-breaker rule, if necessary.
- 5. In case weather conditions are not in our favor, then matches will be played best of seven Games with three all as a tie breaker.
- 6. The tournament shall consist of two singles and one doubles event in both the sections i.e. boys and girls. Two singles matches shall be held first and in the tie case (one all) double will follow.
- 7. Merit Certificates and Medals shall be awarded to the first three positions winning teams in both sections.
- 8. All the other participants shall be awarded the Participation Certificates who actually come to play.
- 9. The decision of the Referee shall be final.
- 10. Players must report 15 minutes in advance in proper kit for the match.
- 11. Players must be prepared to play more than one match in a day.
- 12. The code of conduct for the player shall be strictly observed on and off the field.
- 13. The school Organizing Zone level competition shall take a Group Photo of the teams that have qualified to participate at National level competition. The photo shall be signed by the host School Principal and forwarded to the School organizing next level of competition along with the original entry Proforma.



- 14. Protest, if any, has to be submitted in writing by the Team Coach/ Manager with the Chief Referee, within 15 minutes of the announcement of result. The decision of the Jury of Appeal shall be final.
- 15. The team players reporting on 01 August 2025 will only be allowed to participate in the Championship. Please send your team(s) accordingly.
- 16. The Host School will not be responsible for any misshappening during Championship or during journey.
- 17. All the competitors will bring their personal kit.
- 18. Accommodation will not be provided to the parents accompanying the participants.
- 19. The boarding charges shall be Rs. 500/- per head per day including bedding charges. It is advised that from the health and safety point of view, all participating teams dine in the mess arranged by the Organizing School.
- 20. The participating Schools will deposit payments against meals on full day basis and no part payment will be accepted and the participating schools will not insist for refund of part.

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## **IMPORTANTINSTRUCTIONS:**

- 1. **Opening and Valedictory Ceremony: The** Opening Ceremony will be held at 09.30 AM on 02 August 2025, and the Valedictory Ceremony will be held approximately at 04:00 PM on 05 August 2025.
- 2. Participation in March past is compulsory. Schools are requested to carry their school flag, and students must be in the proper school uniform of their school. Participation in March-Past is compulsory; failing which their right to participate can be forfeited.
- 3. Participation criteria are as per the CBSE Rules of Sports & Games 2025-26.
- 4. **AGE CRITERIA:** No player shall be below 10 years to participate in the Championship.
- 5. Age calculation will be as:
- (i) Under 14 years-Born on or after 01-01-2012
- (ii) Under 17 years-Born on or after 01-01-2009
- (iii) Under 19 years-Born on or after 01-01-2007
- 6. Meeting of Coaches and Managers will be held at 3:00 PM on 01 August 2025.
- 7. The team members must be instructed to observe discipline, code of conduct and to use the school property with utmost care. In case of any damage, deduction will be made from security deposit.
- 8. Participating schools are requested to bring attested and duly signed CBSE Entry Proforma of the participants and Coach/ Manager.
- 9. Girls' team should be compulsory accompanied by female Coach or Manager.
- 10. The participants need to bring their complete Tennis Kit(Racket, shoes, dress).
- 11. Kindly do not touch the materials which are costly and sensitive like-Smart Boards, CCTV Camera, Window glass, Fans, Lights, ACs, almirah etc.
- 12. Team Coach/Manager will be held responsible for any damage/breakage of any item inside the school premises.
- 13. Team should report in the court, half an hour before the start of match.



- 14. It is a No Tobacco/ No Smoke/ No Liquor/ No Drugs Zone, if any illegal material is found, it will have legal consequence.
- 15. Avail the lunch/ dinner etc. as per the timings without making delay by producing the Coupons.
- 16. All information regarding Tennis Championship is available in the Control Room.
- 17. The host School will provide separate accommodations for boys and girls.
- 18. The team Managers and Coaches are supposed to stay with their teams.
- 19. The payment for food & staying will be borne by the teams and the payment for that per head per day @ Rs. 500/- shall be deposited in advance at the Account Section. It will be compulsory for all the participating teams to avail the lodging and meals facility provided by the host school. Only vegetarian food will be served.
- 20. Security deposit of Rs. 2000/ is to be deposited at the time of reporting which is Refundable.
- 21. The team shall be responsible for their belongings and are advised not to carry costly items with them. The contingent must not put damage to the school property. In case of any damage, the participating team will have to bear the cost.
- 22. The team officials are requested to complete all the formalities and clear all the payments before their departure.
- 23. The departing teams are requested to inform four hours prior from their departure to the Accounts Department for clearance of their accounts and for arranging the transport.

## **DISOUALIFICATION**

A player/ team may be disqualified/ scratched for the following reasons.

- 1. If the ineligibility of any member of the team is detected.
- 2. Inclusion of non-bonafide student in the team.
- 3. Misbehavior on ground by participants or accompanying official.
- 4. Use of abusive language by participants or accompanying official.
- 5. Misbehavior with Officials/ Opponents by participants or accompanying official.
- 6. Indiscipline at the place of stay by participants or the accompanying official.
- 7. Damaging the school property.
- 8. Indiscipline during the Opening and Closing Ceremonies by participants or accompanying officials.

## **PROTEST**

Protest of any nature in connection with the tournament shall be in writing and must reach the Organizing Secretary and CBSE Observer within one hour of the declaration of the result, duly accompanied by a fee of Rs. 1000/- (Rupees One Thousand).

Such a protest will be considered by the Jury of Appeal, consisting of the following:

- 1. Principal, Organizing School
- 2. Organizing Secretary
- 3. CBSE Observer
- 4. One or two technically qualified People present at the venue

The parties under dispute may be heard before deciding the issue. Incase the protest is upholding; the protest fee shall be refunded to the protesting school otherwise the fee shall be forfeited.

The decision taken by the Jury of Appeal will be final and binding.

The decision, together with full facts of the protest may immediately be reported to the Deputy Director (Sports) CBSE.

## **MEDALS AND CERTIFICATES**

No Participation Certificate shall be given to a player/ team that does not play after reporting.

## UMPIRES/ REFEREES/ GAME OFFICIAL

Decision of the game officials is final.



Payment for your boarding, food for all four days & security deposit will be accepted ONLY IN CASH on the day of registration.

Note: No other mode of payment will be accepted.

Cost of food and stay per head, per day Rs.500/- Security Deposit Rs. 2000/- Per School (Refundable).
