This quote rightly conveys the importance of collective responsibility, which is a crucial key to conservation efforts like reducing energy consumption and embracing sustainability.

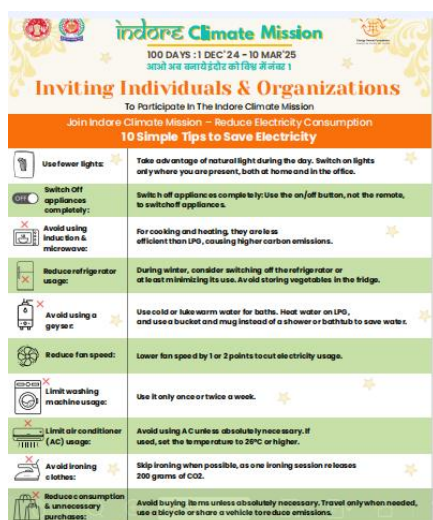
Delhi Public School, Rau proudly participated in the 100-Day Indore Climate Mission, which commenced on **December 1, 2024**. This transformative initiative was flagged by Honourable Mayor of Indore Advocate Shri Pushyamitra Bhargav and launched under the visionary leadership of the Energy Swaraj Foundation, an NGO founded by Dr. Chetan Singh Solanki — widely recognized as the “Solar Man of India.” The mission, coordinated by Mr. Sachin Gupta, aimed to establish Indore as the World’s First Energy Literate City by promoting widespread awareness and encouraging responsible energy practices across all sections of society.

The school initiated its participation with a series of **awareness workshops** for students, teaching and non-teaching staff, and Class IV employees. These sessions educated the school community on climate change, energy conservation, and sustainable lifestyle choices.

*“It is our responsibility as educators to plant the seeds of sustainability in young minds. These workshops were an eye-opener for many,”* shared Ms. Asha Nair, Principal of DPS Rau.



To ensure the mission’s message reach beyond the school boundaries, **Energy Conservation Forms** were distributed. Students, staff, and Class IV workers filled in their **MPEB consumer numbers**, along with those of their **family and friends**, enabling the tracking of energy consumption and encouraging widespread participation in energy-saving practices. Through this we pledged every member of DPS family to adopt measures to reduce electricity consumption by 20% at home and at your workplace and also inspire others to join hands for this noble cause.

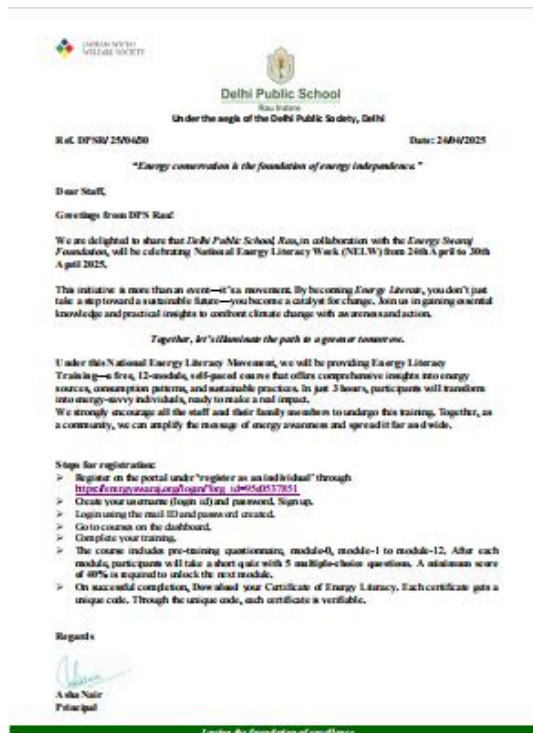
